#### What Makes A Will Valid?

A will is not valid unless it is in writing, and signed by the testator (the person making the will) or by another person, in the presence of, and at the direction of the testator. The testator's signature must be made with the intention of executing the will, and in the presence of two or more witnesses.






These witnesses must attest and sign the will in the presence of the testator. They need not be in the presence of each other in order to sign the document, as long as the testator is present at the time of each signing.

I am writing this book to increase the faith in God for those who will read it. For them to know God is real. You must be obedient to the spirit when you hear God speak?




