#### WE HAVE NO CULTURE

A culture is a thing that is separate and distinct and causes others to recognize at a glance those physical objects and sociological activities as things belonging to a particular group of people. Cultures have been around before those living in them knew what they were. We, the African-American, have no culture. We have not, in anyway, raised ourselves above who we were and what we were made to be as a single group. Therefore and very painfully, We are cultivated but not as who and what we are, we are cultivated in the ways of other cultures. We as a people were bred in the U.S. of A. on stud farms like domestic animals. We were bred through a process of mongrelization or miscegenationally created because we were given a way as gifts, precious gems, and play toys.

The only thing exclusively to our people, up until this point in our lives, with no exceptions, is our ability to create music such as jazz, gospel, rap and hiphop. Jazz is a hot uncontrollable form of music that speaks emotions in a language that takes you beyond standard music. Gospel is our people's personal contact with God; rap and hip hop are music forms and styles born from our existence. Beyond our music, we have no personal idiosyncrasies or race specific mannerisms that we did not bar-

row from another people. We as a people are the sum total of all the people that compose us. We are, and we are alone. We stand on the bottle rung of the ladder of progressive living. We lie down before all others and allow them to use us as stepping stones to a higher level. Unacceptably, we are cultureless, we have no power to negotiate our position. As we are now in this country, we have nothing to cause the higher power to reciprocate the power to be. There is no compensation we will receive for being what they made us. We are the ambassadors of human stupidity, the diplomats of forced blindness, and the emissaries of racial disunity. We are what we are because we have allowed ourselves to be consciously and unconsciously sculptured from the undesirable clay of other people.

We must open our eyes as a people and take a good look at ourselves, before all we could be is no more. We must develop a language, a form of writing that is exclusive to us as a people, clothes, and other idiosyncratic psychosomatic realities indicative of our existence. We have no culture now, but with an assertive effort put forth by us as a single cause, we can create one. Think about it, as you realize the fact that, we are the newest people on this earth, and we must develop a new culture to go with our newness.



As a consequence of the phenomenal abundance in food wealth the human population grew tremendously going from approximately 10 million people to 300 million in just 8,000 years (from 8,000 B.C. - 1 B.C.). Where we are now, 2,000 years later, the population has grown to more than 7.5 billion people; all due to agriculture the abundance of food as the foundation.

With the abundance of food, Black Civilization and societies flourished a round the planet. Black societies founded on the agricultural 'way of life' manifested all manner of development, wealth and beauty. These developments were expressed in government, science, culture, and technology. Combined, these elements in Black societies manifested in art, fashion, music, cooking, language, inventions, peace, wealth, spirituality, travel, and all manner of social cultural, intellectual technological, economic and political expression.
