Residents are still waiting to get a copy of a purported 'Crime Plan." Violent crimes include: Murder and Non-negligent Manslaughter, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assault. Residents complain of over 100 Daily Open Air Drug Markets in predominantly poorer and African American Communities. Special attention and now declaring crime out of control seems to come when the affluent and white communities are affected. Talks regarding another Class Action Law Suit, similar to the one the MD ACLU and MD and Baltimore City NAACP filed and WON to address this matter. I was humbled to have been the President of the Baltimore City Branch NAACP that was a winning Plaintiff in that case.

American Airlines Alert

A nationwide demand has to be made of American Airlines to sit down with the NAACP and other civil rights organizations to address concerns and complaints by patrons alleging issues of safety, discrimination, and disrespect. NAACP has to be both thanked and commended for taking the leadership in this area. The NAACP has issued an alert which includes: "...The series of recent incidents involving troublesome conduct by American Airlines and they suggest a corporate culture of racial insensitivity and possible racial bias on the part of American Airlines."

Mental Health Crisis in Baltimore **City**
