There are dozens of political parties that exist in America and most get little or no recognition. Why? U.S. elections only reward what is known as "first past the post" (FPTP). The one who gets the most votes...wins. Most of our nation's other political parties are hardly ever mentioned.

Some other people feel that the registration and voting process takes way too much work and time. In many other countries, being a citizen is being automatically registered to vote. In other words, if you are a citizen, and don't screw up...you are registered to vote.

Again, there are many people, organizations, and institutions that are still working very hard to restrict certain groups of peoples' voting privileges right now. Nothing (No-Thing) last forever and nothing stays the same. Just think about this one question...If it can be voted in...Can it voted out? Nothing (No-Thing) last forever and nothing stays the same. # What Makes A Will Valid?

A will is not valid unless it is in writing, and signed by the testator (the person making the will) or by another person, in the presence of, and at the direction of the testator. The testator's signature must be made with the intention of executing the will, and in the presence of two or more witnesses.






These witnesses must attest and sign the will in the presence of the testator. They need not be in the presence of each other in order to sign the document, as long as the testator is present at the time of each signing.




